Why It Matters: High-voltage and limited energy circuits routed too closely can cause cross-talk, distortion, or packet errors, especially in dense cable trays or congested ceiling spaces. **Best Practice:** Use separate trays, conduits, or divider systems to isolate voltage. NEC Article 392 governs cable tray installations, covering tray types, fill limits, cable types permitted, and ampacity adjustments. The fill rules differ significantly between single-conductor cables and multiconductor cables, and between ladder tray and solid-bottom tray. EMI risk increases with parallel runs and long shared pathways. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray is used for instrumentation and control applications that require. These systems provide an efficient and adaptable solution for managing a wide range of cables, including power cables, control cables, Ethernet, and fiber optic lines. The flexibility and scalability of cable trays make them an ideal choice for environments where cable density and organization can. NEC Article 392 outlines the key rules for installing and maintaining industrial cable tray systems. The power wiring is type 'TC' cable, but the data wiring is un-marked.
