Fiber optic cable cabinets are specialized enclosures designed to organize, protect, and manage fiber optic cables for indoor and outdoor network applications.

Types of Fiber Optic Cabinets

1. **Floor-Mounted Cabinets** These cabinets are typically larger, offering extensive space for fiber distribution and network equipment. They often include vertical cable management channels, multiple cable entry points, and brush strip holes for neat routing. Many come with wheels and adjustable feet for mobility and stability, and are delivered either fully assembled or flat-packed for on-site assembly. Floor cabinets are ideal for data centers and telecom rooms where high-density fiber management is required (Foss), .

2. **Wall-Mounted Cabinets** Wall-mounted cabinets are compact and suitable for smaller spaces or building entry points. They usually range in depth from 30 to 60 cm and heights from 6U to 16U. Features include removable side panels, dark glass doors, optional locks, and compatibility with accessories like PDUs, lighting, and fan systems. These cabinets are designed for secure and efficient housing of fiber optic and network equipment (Foss), .

3. **Outdoor Fiber Distribution Cabinets** Outdoor cabinets are built to withstand harsh environmental conditions. They are often made from weather-resistant, recyclable polycarbonate or high-grade metals, providing protection against moisture, dust, and extreme temperatures. These cabinets support GPON and PtP fiber access networks and include modular designs with integrated fiber cassettes and microduct management for easy installation and expansion (Langmatz), .

4. **Fiber Distribution Hubs (FDH) and Modular Cabinets** FDH cabinets serve as hubs for splicing, organizing, and routing fiber cables. They can be ground-mounted, pole-mounted, or wall-mounted. Modular designs allow customization based on network requirements, including options for battery drawers, risers, and plug-and-play configurations. These cabinets improve network performance by enabling easy access for maintenance and reconfiguration (Multilink), .

5. **Fiber Entrance Cabinets (FEC)** FECs are designed for high-density connections in data centers or central offices. They manage thousands of fiber connections efficiently and provide secure access for maintenance. These cabinets are often equipped with advanced locking systems to prevent unauthorized access and ensure network security (CommScope), .
