- o **Qualified Personnel:** Installation must be performed by personnel familiar with the Canadian Electrical Code (CEC) and provincial regulations .
- o **Support Structures:** Use trapeze hangers, center-span supports, or wall brackets to anchor trays to ceilings, walls, or floors. Maximum load per hanger typically ranges from 318 kg to 340 kg, with support spacing up to 3.6 m .
- o **Prefabrication:** Prefabricated assemblies and modular sections reduce on-site labor and allow for faster installation and removal .
- o **Storage and Handling:** Ladder trays can be stored outdoors if stacked on dunnage to prevent moisture contact. PVC or painted trays require additional protection .
- o **Safety Considerations:** Trays are mechanical supports, not walkways or lifting devices. Drilling into structural members requires general contractor approval .

Automation and Mechanization

While fully robotic cable tray installation is not yet widespread, automation can be achieved through:

- o **Prefabricated Tray Sections:** Pre-assembled straight sections, bends, and tees reduce manual fitting on-site .
- o **Mechanized Lifting Tools:** Hoists, trolleys, and battery-powered cutters allow faster placement and removal of heavy trays, especially wire mesh or ladder types .

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o Integrated Layout Planning: Using CAD and BIM software ensures precise routing, minimizing manual adjustments and reducing installation time .
