Butterfly-shaped drop cables are commonly known as FTTH butterfly optical cables, flat drop fiber cables, or indoor suspended cables.

Butterfly-shaped drop cables are a type of fiber optic cable designed for last-mile broadband delivery. Their name comes from the cable's cross-sectional profile, which resembles a butterfly: a flat, symmetrical shape with two strength members flanking a central optical fiber unit . This design allows the cable to bend easily, resist stress, and fit along walls, window frames, or conduit entries, making it ideal for indoor and outdoor installations .

Structure and Variants

The typical butterfly cable consists of:

- o Central optical fiber: Usually G.657A1 or G.657A2 single-mode fibers, which tolerate tight bends .
- o Strength members: Non-metallic (FRP or KFRP) or metallic (steel wire) components on either side of the fiber for tensile strength and protection .
- o Outer jacket: PVC or LSZH material for environmental protection . Variants include indoor and outdoor versions, with outdoor cables generally costing more due to additional protective features . The cable can be single-core for residential use or multi-core (2-4 cores) for business applications .

Advantages

- o Lightweight and compact, reducing installation effort .
- o Highly bend-resistant, suitable for tight indoor routing .
- o Easy to fix and connect in terminal boxes .
- o Cost-effective and reliable for subscriber drop connections .
