

# Can I connect IPTV to a switch after getting a fiber optic cable to my home

## Preview

You need to run a separate cable/switch on port 3 for the IPTV network, and put the "main" network switch on another port. Since your (or rather your provider's) IPTV setup seems to be somewhat lacking in sophistication, you probably won't be able to have all devices in. I am using an ISP which delivers fibre optic cable to my home, which terminates at their device (can't remove it unfortunately) which is a media convertor to RJ45. Ports 1 and 2 are dedicated for Internet (VLAN 558, confirmed from their end) and ports 3 and 4 are dedicated for IPTV (VLAN 658). My.
