

Can a laser diode be used at a distance of 5 meters

Preview

The short answer is yes, for 2 reasons: Beam divergence is a measure of how fast a laser expands as it travels past its focus point. Going from a 5 mW to a 500 mW laser is a 100 times power increase -- but the hazard distances only become 10 times as long. Because the beam is spreading out faster, the power. Low-power lasers, such as the common laser pointers used in classrooms or for presentations, typically range from 1mW to 5mW. We design these lasers for close-range use, but under ideal conditions--such as clear, dark skies--their beams can still remain visible over surprisingly long distances.
