

Can cable trays be installed in a ventilated machine room

Preview

Due to their exposure to the open air because of the cable trays, the wires contained within need a very durable outer covering. The regulations dictate that the cables must either be Type TC (also known as Tray Rated) or must be metal-armored (Type MC). It has a UL two hour fire resistive rating. In industrial establishments where conditions of maintenance and supervision assure that only qualified persons will service the installed cable tray system, the following cables may also be installed in ladder, ventilated-trough, or ventilated-channel cable trays: (a) Single conductor cable.

Ventilated trough tray has a solid bottom with ventilation openings (typically 1/4-inch to 1-inch slots or holes). It provides moderate ventilation and

Overloading cable trays can lead to a breakdown of the tray, its connecting points, and/or supports, causing hazards to persons underneath the cable tray and even leading to possible electric shock

Ladder, ventilated trough, ventilated channel or solid bottom cable tray may be installed to support the applicable types of cables specifically listed for the use.

Adequate room should be provided around the cable tray to allow for the set-up of cable pulling equipment and to provide easy access for the installation of or removal of cables.

A generic guideline developed by the Cable Tray Institute indicates that cable trays should not be filled in excess of 40-50% of the inside area of the tray or of the tray's maximum weight based on the cable

Ventilated trough trays are designed for smaller cables, offering both support and airflow. They prevent small-diameter instrumentation cables from sagging between rungs while also enabling
