

Can fiber optic cables be connected in series with routers

Fiber optic cables cannot be connected directly to a standard router; they require an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to convert light signals into Ethernet signals that the router can use.

Why Direct Connection Doesn't Work

Fiber optic cables transmit data as pulses of light through glass or plastic strands, whereas standard routers use Ethernet ports that carry electrical signals over copper wiring. The two signal types are fundamentally incompatible, and the physical connectors are different, so a fiber cable cannot plug directly into a typical home router .

Proper Setup with an ONT

- o Optical Network Terminal (ONT): This device, usually provided by your ISP, receives the fiber optic cable and converts the optical signal into a standard electrical Ethernet signal .
- o Router Connection: After conversion, the ONT outputs the signal via an Ethernet port. You then connect this port to your router's WAN port using a Cat5e or Cat6 Ethernet cable .
- o Router Configuration: Once connected, the router functions normally, distributing the internet to your devices over wired or wireless connections. From the router's perspective, it is receiving a standard Ethernet signal, so it does not need to be fiber-specific unless you want to use advanced features like SFP ports for direct fiber input .

Optional Fiber Network Expansion

If you want to extend fiber connections beyond the ONT, you can use fiber switches or media converters. These devices allow multiple fiber cables to interconnect or convert between single-mode and multi-mode fiber, but they still require proper conversion to Ethernet before connecting to a standard router .
