

Connecting a new router to a fiber optic router

To connect a new router to a fiber optic internet setup, you must link the Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to your router via Ethernet, then configure the router using your ISP credentials.

Step 1: Understand the Components

Fiber optic internet requires an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts the incoming light signals from the fiber line into electrical signals your router can use . Your new router should have a WAN or Internet port to receive this signal. You will also need a high-quality Ethernet cable (Cat6a or higher) to connect the ONT to the router .

Step 2: Physical Connections

- o Locate the fiber wall outlet where the ISP's fiber line enters your home .
- o Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's optical input port. Handle the fiber connector carefully to avoid dirt or damage .
- o Link the ONT to your router using an Ethernet cable: plug one end into the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port and the other into the router's WAN/Internet port .
- o Power on the ONT first, allowing it to establish a connection with your ISP. Wait for the status lights to stabilize, usually 2-5 minutes .
- o Power on your router and wait for its indicator lights to confirm a successful connection .

Step 3: Router Configuration

- o Access the router's admin panel via a web browser using its IP address (commonly 192.168.1.1 or 192.168.0.1), .
- o Enter your ISP-provided credentials to authenticate the connection.
- o Update the router's firmware if necessary to ensure compatibility and security.
- o Configure Wi-Fi settings, including network name (SSID) and password, and enable Quality of Service (QoS) if you use VoIP or video streaming .

Step 4: Placement and Maintenance

- o Place the ONT and router near power outlets and in a dry, ventilated area .
- o Use a surge protector to safeguard your equipment.
- o Periodically check the status lights on both devices to ensure the connection remains stable . By following these steps, your new router will be properly connected to your fiber optic network, providing high-speed, low-latency internet throughout your home .

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Depending on your router, you'll want to make sure that the VLAN is applied to the WAN or all wired ports and wireless connections.
