Common Fiber Optic Connectors

SC (Subscriber Connector): A square-shaped connector with a push-pull coupling mechanism, widely used in FTTH deployments, data centers, and GPON networks where low return loss is critical . It uses a 2.5mm ferrule and is known for durability and ease of use. **LC (Lucent Connector):** A smaller form-factor connector with a 1.25mm ferrule, ideal for high-density applications such as data centers and telecom racks. It uses a latch mechanism similar to an RJ45 plug, providing secure connections in tight spaces . **ST (Straight Tip):** A round connector with a bayonet-style twist-lock mechanism, commonly used in legacy networks and industrial applications. It is durable and allows quick connections . **MTP/MPO (Multi-Fiber Push-On/Pull-Off):** High-density connectors that can terminate multiple fibers in a single connector, often used in backbone cabling and high-speed data centers . Other types: SMA, FDDI/MIC, and ESCON connectors are less common today but may be used in specialized or legacy systems .

Choosing the Right Connector

- o **Fiber Type:** Single-mode fibers typically use SC, LC, or APC variants for low insertion and return loss, while multimode fibers often use SC, LC, or ST connectors .
- o **Application:** High-density environments favor LC or MPO connectors, whereas simpler setups may use SC or ST connectors .
- o **Performance Requirements:** Consider insertion loss, return loss, and durability. APC (Angled Physical Contact) connectors reduce back reflection, making them suitable for RF video or GPON networks .
- o **Compatibility:** Ensure the connector matches patch panels, transceivers, and other network equipment to avoid mismatched connections .
