Understanding Fiber Bundling

Optical fibers are extremely delicate, with diameters typically between 0.2 and 1.2 mm, and can break under excessive tension or bending . Industrial bundling machines, like those from KURRE Systems, use high-speed spinners and controlled tension to wrap a binder yarn around multiple fibers, ensuring uniform bundles without damaging the fibers . For DIY purposes, the key principles are gentle handling, even tension, and consistent bundling.

DIY Approaches

1. Manual Bundling with Fiber Binding Tape

For small-scale projects, you can bundle fibers manually using optical fiber binding tape:

- o Arrange fibers neatly in parallel without crossover.
- o Cut a piece of binding tape slightly longer than the bundle.
- o Wrap the tape around the fibers, ensuring the mat side contacts the fibers and the hook side faces outward.
- o Apply gentle tension to secure the bundle without compressing the fibers too tightly.
- o Maximum bundle sizes: ~100 fibers of 2 mm diameter or 60 fibers of 3 mm diameter .

2. Semi-Automated Winder

A simple DIY machine can mimic industrial bundlers:

- o Rotating spindle or disc: Mount a small motor or hand crank to rotate a spool.
- o Fiber guide: Use smooth tubes or rollers to feed fibers evenly to the spindle.
- o Binder application: Wrap a thin thread or tape around the fibers as they rotate.
- o Tension control: Add springs or adjustable rollers to maintain low, consistent tension (0.2-4 N in industrial systems).
- o Accumulator: Optional spool holder to feed multiple fibers continuously.

3. Safety and Handling

- o Avoid sharp bends or pulling fibers forcibly.

- o Keep fibers clean and free from dust or debris.
- o Use protective sleeves or corrugated tubing if needed during bundling .
- o Test the bundle for uniformity and minimal stress before splicing or installation.

Additional Tips

- o Start with a small number of fibers to refine your setup.
- o Use color-coded threads or tapes to identify bundles.
- o For higher precision, consider a small stepper motor with adjustable speed to rotate the winder evenly.
- o Always handle fibers with gloves or tweezers to prevent oils or scratches. By combining these principles, you can create a DIY optical cable bundling machine suitable for small-scale fiber projects, prototyping, or educational purposes, while minimizing the risk of fiber damage .
