Common Materials

Metal Enclosures:

- o Steel (stainless or galvanized): Offers high strength, excellent impact resistance, and corrosion protection, making it ideal for industrial or outdoor applications .
- o Aluminum: Lightweight, rust-resistant, and suitable for residential or low-voltage installations .
- o Epoxy-coated steel: Provides additional corrosion resistance and is used in metallic deep-drawn boxes .

Plastic Enclosures:

- o Polycarbonate (PC): Strong, lightweight, shatter-resistant, and flame-retardant, suitable for residential and commercial use .

- o Sheet Molding Compounds (SMC): Thermoset plastic with high heat resistance, though heavier and less recyclable than PC or ASA .
- o Fiberglass-reinforced plastic: Provides impact resistance and flame retardancy for light-duty or indoor applications .

Key Material Properties

- o Impact Resistance: Materials must withstand accidental bumps, knocks, or falls without cracking .
- o Fire and Heat Resistance: Flame-retardant materials like polycarbonate, fiberglass, or metal with flame-resistant coatings prevent fire spread and withstand high temperatures .
- o Corrosion Resistance: Metals are often galvanized or stainless to resist rust, especially in humid, chemical, or coastal environments .
- o Electrical Safety: Materials should sustain surge voltages (e.g., 2kV for one minute) and resist tracking and heat up to 70°C .
- o Sealing and Protection: Plastic boxes often use polyurethane or silicone foams to seal grooves, protecting electronics from dust and moisture, meeting IP and NEMA standards .

Application Considerations

- o Industrial/Heavy-Duty: Stainless steel or galvanized steel is preferred for durability and corrosion resistance .
- o Residential/Light-Duty: Polycarbonate or ASA plastics are cost-effective, lightweight, and provide sufficient

- o Outdoor Use: Materials must resist UV, moisture, and temperature extremes; silicone or polyurethane sealing foams enhance protection .
