Ultrasonic testing may be used to detect hidden weld defects . **Electrical and Mechanical Testing:** Finished boxes undergo mechanical strength tests, insulation resistance checks, grounding verification, and load testing. Ingress protection (IP) tests ensure dustproof and waterproof performance . **Packaging and Storage Inspection:** Packaging integrity is verified to prevent damage during transport. Storage conditions, including temperature and humidity, are monitored to maintain product quality .

Preventive Maintenance and Operational Inspection

External Inspection: Check for corrosion, physical damage, legible labels, overheating, or arcing. Ensure the box is securely mounted and connections are tight . **Internal Inspection:** Open the box to inspect for dust, debris, burnt wiring, and proper operation of circuit breakers and surge protection devices . **Testing:** Measure voltage levels, perform insulation resistance tests, and verify grounding continuity. Test monitoring or alarm systems for proper operation . **Cleaning and Documentation:** Remove dust and corrosion, ensure ventilation openings are clear, and record all findings, repairs, and maintenance actions. Update logs for future reference and schedule the next inspection .
