Distribution box height varies by model, typically ranging from 75 mm to 140 mm for plastic units, with recommended wall-mounted installation heights of 1.4 to 1.7 meters for accessibility and safety.

Box Height Specifications

Distribution boxes come in various sizes depending on the series and number of ways (outlets) they support. For example:

- o Plastic distribution boxes (HA, HK, LGD series): Heights range from 75 mm to 140 mm, with lengths from 100 mm to 415 mm and widths from 105 mm to 323 mm .
- o MB-ABC series: Heights are typically 95 mm, with lengths from 200 mm to 328 mm and widths around 172-174 mm .
- o TOP series (TOP-TS, TOP-TF, TOP-LS, TOP-PS, TOP-PF, TOP-S): Dimensions include length, width, and height, varying according to the number of ways (1-36 ways) and specific model . The height of the box is a critical factor for internal cable space, proper mounting of protective devices (MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs), and compliance with standards such as IEC 61439 and BS 7671 .

Recommended Installation Height

For safe and convenient use, distribution boxes should be installed at specific heights:

- o Wall-mounted indoor boxes: 4.5 to 5.5 feet (1.4 to 1.7 meters) above the floor, allowing easy access without bending or stretching .
- o Outdoor boxes: At least 3 feet (0.9 meters) above ground to prevent water ingress and dirt accumulation .
- o Ground-mounted boxes: Raised 2 to 4 inches to avoid moisture damage . These installation heights ensure compliance with standards like BS 7671 and IEC 60364-5-52, while also facilitating maintenance, label readability, and emergency access .

Additional Considerations

When selecting a distribution box, consider:

- o Material: Flame-resistant ABS plastic or corrosion-resistant metal for durability .
- o Internal layout: Adequate space for busbars, neutral and earth bars, DIN rails, and cable entries .
- o Protection rating: IP rating for dust and water resistance, especially for outdoor or industrial installations .
- o Number of ways: Ensure sufficient circuits plus spare capacity for future expansion . Proper selection and
