A 6 kW distribution box typically handles 25-30 A per phase and requires a compact enclosure of approximately 300-400 mm width, 400-500 mm height, and 150-200 mm depth, depending on the number of outgoing circuits and protective devices.

Electrical Specifications

- o Rated Power: 6 kW
- o Voltage: Usually 230 V single-phase or 400 V three-phase depending on installation
- o Rated Current: For single-phase: $6 \text{ kW} / 230 \text{ V} \approx 26 \text{ A}$; for three-phase: $6 \text{ kW} / (\sqrt{3} \times 400 \text{ V}) \approx 8.7 \text{ A}$ per phase
