- o Attachment Methods: Supports can be mounted to ceilings, walls, or floors using brackets, hangers, or channel systems. All mounting hardware must be rated for the load and environmental conditions .
- o Bonding and Grounding: When metal trays are used, supports must allow for proper electrical continuity and grounding to meet NEC 392.60 requirements. This ensures the tray can serve as an equipment grounding conductor if needed .
- o Environmental Considerations: In corrosive or high-moisture environments, materials such as stainless steel or fiberglass-reinforced plastic may be used, and supports must be compatible with these materials to maintain long-term stability .

Safety and Compliance

Securing cable tray supports is not optional; it is a critical safety requirement. Properly installed supports prevent mechanical failure, maintain cable organization, and ensure compliance with electrical codes. Additionally, securing supports helps maintain the correct cable bend radius and prevents excessive sagging, which can lead to overheating or insulation damage .
