- o Fiber Termination Box: Found indoors, often in corridors or buildings, connecting vertical and horizontal fiber cables. It contains splice trays, optical splitters, and protection units .
- o Fiber Customer Box: Smaller boxes for individual homes, usually 4-core, managing the final connection to the user .
- o Industrial Fiber Distribution Boxes: Designed for rugged environments, made from durable materials like ABS+PC, with dustproof and waterproof features, and versatile mounting options .

## Key Features

- o Splice trays: Organize and protect spliced fibers.
- o Connectors and adapters: Facilitate quick, stable connections.

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- o Environmental protection: IP68-rated boxes resist water and dust, ensuring long-term reliability .
- o Optical splitters: Distribute signals to multiple fibers, often installed in termination or distribution boxes .
