- o Ensure fill capacity of the tray is not exceeded to avoid overheating and maintain proper ampacity .
- o Use compatible fittings and accessories to maintain support at changes in elevation or direction .
- o Installation should comply with NEC Article 392 and local electrical codes, ensuring that MI cables are properly secured and protected within the tray system .
