

Dorm fiber optic internet can connect to a router

- o Confirm ONT Setup: Ensure your ISP has installed and activated the ONT in your dorm room.
- o Connect Fiber to ONT: Plug the fiber optic cable into the ONT's optical port, handling the connector carefully to avoid damage.
- o Link ONT to Router: Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to your router's WAN port.
- o Power On Devices: Turn on the ONT first, wait for the status lights to stabilize, then power on your router.
- o Configure Router Settings: Access the router's admin panel to set up VLAN, DHCP, or PPPoE settings if required by your ISP.
- o Test Connection: Verify internet speed and connectivity to ensure the router is properly handling the fiber input.

Compatibility Considerations

- o Routers designed for DSL or cable internet (phone line or coaxial inputs) will not work with fiber.
- o Ensure the router's WAN and LAN ports support the speed tier of your fiber plan to avoid bottlenecks.
- o Using a modern router with Wi-Fi 6/6E ensures better device management and full utilization of fiber speeds.
