Key Features

Construction and Materials: These boxes are typically made from cast aluminum, stainless steel, or heavy-duty malleable iron, offering corrosion resistance, high impact tolerance, and durability in extreme temperatures . They are designed to contain internal explosions and prevent ignition of external gases, vapors, or dust.

Certifications: Look for ATEX, IECEx, and UL 1203 certifications to ensure compliance with hazardous location standards. These certifications indicate suitability for Zones 1, 2, 21, 22 or Class I and II, Division 1 environments .

Ingress Protection (IP) Ratings: Most explosion-proof boxes have IP66 or higher, making them dust-tight and resistant to water jets, suitable for both indoor and outdoor storefront installations .

Applications: They are ideal for power distribution, control circuits, terminal connections, and network or sensor equipment in areas where flammable substances may be present, such as chemical stores, gas stations, or food processing areas .

Types and Options

- o **Conduit Outlet Boxes:** Available in multiple hub configurations (e.g., 1/2", 3/4", 1") for threaded metal conduit installations. Examples include Appleton GR, GRSS, and GRX series .
- o **Distribution Boxes with Transformers:** ATEX-certified step-down transformers integrated into explosion-proof enclosures for 24V, 110V, or 220V outputs .
- o **Terminal and Junction Boxes (Ex d / Ex tb):** Modular designs with aluminum or stainless steel, configurable with various terminals, cable entries, and optional viewing windows .
- o **Compact and Budget-Friendly Options:** Smaller boxes (3"x3"x2") for sensors or compact circuits, medium (6"x6"x4") for cable terminations, and large (12"x10"x8") for control panels .

- o **Mounting:** Securely attach to walls or stands using certified fasteners.
- o **Conduit Connections:** Use pre-threaded entries or cable glands compatible with your conduit system.
- o **Sealing:** Ensure gaskets and covers are intact to maintain explosion-proof integrity.
- o **Compliance:** Follow local electrical codes (e.g., NEC Article 500) and manufacturer instructions .
