Ribbon cable can be spliced more rapidly by using mass fusion splicing technique. Fusion splice is a junction of two or more optical fibers that have been melted together. Fusion splicing is the most widely used method of splicing as it provides for the lowest loss and least reflectance, as well as providing the strongest and most reliable joint between two fibers. Ribbon cables also enable mass-fusion splicing, whereby each 12-fiber ribbon can be spliced in a single. Fiber Management System (FMS), such as IANOS and LISA from HUBER+SUHNER, are compatible with the OptiRibbon cable, which means operators do not require an overhaul of their existing infrastructure to implement the Ribbon solution. This also leads to significant cost savings.
