



Gigabit or 100Mbps Enterprise Fiber Optic Router

Gigabit Fiber Routers

For fiber plans offering 1 Gbps or higher, you need routers that support multi-gigabit speeds, modern Wi-Fi standards, and robust wired connections:

- o NETGEAR Nighthawk Tri-Band WiFi 7 Router (RS700S): Supports speeds up to 1,900 Mbps for gaming, 4K/8K streaming, and AR/VR applications. It has a 1 Gigabit WAN port, 2 Gigabit LAN ports, OFDMA+MU-MIMO for connecting 256+ devices, and mesh support for whole-home coverage .
- o ASUS RT-BE86U: Wi-Fi 7 router with a quad-core 2.6 GHz CPU, 10G WAN/LAN ports, and dual 2.5G/10G flexibility. It delivers high throughput for multiple users and smart home devices, with speeds up to 6.5 Gbps under optimal conditions .
- o TP-Link AC1900 Smart WiFi Router (Archer A8): Budget-friendly option for gigabit fiber, offering dual-band Wi-Fi, multiple gigabit Ethernet ports, and good coverage for medium-sized homes . These routers are ideal for heavy streaming, gaming, cloud backups, and multiple connected devices, ensuring low latency and full utilization of high-speed fiber plans .

100 Mbps Fiber Routers

- o LAN/WAN Ports: Ensure the router has enough gigabit or multi-gig ports for wired devices.
- o Device Capacity: Consider MU-MIMO and OFDMA for multiple simultaneous connections.
- o Coverage: Mesh support or high-gain antennas help cover larger homes.
- o Security: Look for built-in firewalls, VPN support, and parental controls.
