

Home Fiber Optic Router Connection Diagram

A home fiber optic connection runs from the ISP's fiber line to an ONT, then to your router, which distributes internet to all devices via Ethernet or Wi-Fi.

Fiber Optic Connection Overview

- o **Fiber Line Entry:** The fiber optic cable from your Internet Service Provider (ISP) enters your home, typically through a utility room or basement. This cable carries data as pulses of light, providing high-speed, low-latency internet .
- o **Optical Network Terminal (ONT):** The fiber connects to an ONT, which converts the optical signal into an electrical signal suitable for your router. The ONT is the bridge between the ISP's network and your home network .
- o **Router Connection:** An Ethernet cable runs from the ONT to the WAN port of your router. The router then creates a local network (LAN) and manages traffic to all connected devices .
- o **Device Connections:**
 - o **Wired Devices:** Computers, smart TVs, or gaming consoles can connect directly to the router's LAN ports using Ethernet cables.
 - o **Wireless Devices:** Laptops, smartphones, and tablets connect via Wi-Fi. For larger homes, additional Wi-Fi access points or mesh nodes can extend coverage and eliminate dead zones .
- o **Optional Network Switch:** If you have many wired devices in one area, a network switch can expand the number of available Ethernet ports, connecting multiple devices to a single router port .
