Physical Access and Safety

If your distribution box is physically blocked by furniture, storage, or other obstacles, clear a minimum of 3 feet of space in front of the panel to allow safe access for operation and emergency shutoff . Never attempt to move or access the panel if you are unsure about live electrical components; always prioritize safety.

Common Causes of Operational Blockage

- o Overcrowding: Too many circuits or wires in the panel can make it difficult to operate breakers and may cause frequent tripping .
- o Insufficient Capacity: Older panels may not handle modern electrical loads, leading to overheating or blocked operation due to safety mechanisms .
- o Corrosion or Rust: Moisture exposure can deteriorate internal components, making breakers stiff or difficult to reset .
- o Loose Connections: Wires that are not properly secured can create arcing, heat, and operational difficulty .

- o Inspect the Panel: Ensure the panel door opens fully and that no wires or components are obstructing breaker access .
- o Reduce Load: Unplug or redistribute devices if breakers trip frequently, which can indicate overcrowding .
- o Check for Corrosion or Damage: Look for rust, discoloration, or charred components; these may require replacement .
- o Tighten Connections: Only a qualified electrician should tighten internal connections to prevent shock or fire hazards .
