Hot-dip galvanized cable trays are not fully fireproof and offer only limited fire resistance.

Hot-dip galvanized cable trays are coated with a layer of zinc to protect against corrosion, which makes them highly durable in harsh environments, but this coating does not provide complete fire protection . Zinc melts at relatively low temperatures, and during a fire, the galvanized layer can fail quickly, compromising the tray's structural integrity and allowing fire to spread . While these trays may undergo fire prevention treatments, such as fireproof coatings, these measures only enhance fire resistance and cannot guarantee full fireproofing .

Limitations in Fire Situations

- o Partial protection only: The galvanized coating may delay heat transfer slightly, but it does not prevent flames from affecting the cables inside the tray .
- o Heat and current effects: Operational heat and electrical current can exacerbate fire risks, potentially causing fire accidents even in treated trays .
- o Not suitable for high-risk areas: In environments with high fire hazard potential, hot-dip galvanized trays should be supplemented with additional fireproofing measures or replaced with fire-rated trays .

Recommended Fire Safety Measures

To ensure safety in buildings and industrial installations, additional precautions are necessary:

- o Fire partitions: Installing barriers to contain fire spread along cable routes.
- o Automatic fire suppression systems: Sprinklers or other extinguishing systems to control fire outbreaks.
- o Fire-rated penetration sealing: Sealing openings where trays pass through walls or floors to prevent fire propagation .
- o Compliance with fire safety standards: Ensuring all electrical equipment and wiring meet relevant regulations .

Alternative Options

For environments where fire resistance is critical, consider:

- o Fire-coated steel trays: These trays have a fire-resistant coating that forms an insulating layer during a fire, significantly reducing fire spread .
- o Stainless steel trays: While not fireproof, stainless steel maintains structural integrity at high temperatures and is suitable where corrosion resistance is also important .

o Aluminum trays: Lightweight and corrosion-resistant but unsuitable for fire-prone areas due to low melting point and high heat conductivity .
