

How many weights does a single cable tray support weigh

For a tray segment carrying 22 lb/ft over a 10-foot span, each support would bear about 110 pounds before safety factors or additional loads are considered . For heavier installations, such as multiple large conductors, the total support load can exceed 100 pounds per foot, requiring structural engineering review .
