

How to connect a fiber optic cable with one inlet and three outlets to a junction box

Ensure each fiber is properly seated in the adapter or connector, and maintain the bend radius throughout the routing . 6. Test the Connections After all fibers are connected, use a fiber optic power meter or OTDR to verify signal integrity and check for any weak or lost signals. Adjust connections if necessary to ensure optimal performance . 7. Finalize and Maintain Close the junction box securely, keeping it free from dust and moisture. Schedule regular inspections to check for loose connections, damaged fibers, or environmental degradation .
