Components Needed

A typical kit includes:

- o 131 ft of 600-micron single-mode fiber
- o Two 1-Gigabit media converters to convert Ethernet to fiber and back
- o Two Cat6 Ethernet cables
- o Adhesive, cleaning wipes, and installation tools
- o Standard U.S. power adapters for the media converters No additional configuration is required; the system is plug-and-play.

Installation Steps

- o Plan the Fiber Path: Determine the route from your router to the target device, considering corners, baseboards, and doorways .
- o Position Media Converters: Place one converter near the router and the other near the device.
- o Connect Ethernet Cables: Plug a Cat6 cable from the router to the first media converter and from the second converter to your device.
- o Connect Fiber Optic Cable: Attach the fiber between the two media converters. Ensure the fiber is not pinched or sharply bent; the G.657.B3 fiber tolerates tight bends up to 2.5mm radius .
- o Power Up: Connect the media converters to power and turn on your devices.
- o Test the Connection: Verify internet access and speed. If issues arise, check all connections and restart devices as needed .
- o Adhere Fiber: Use the included adhesive to secure the fiber along the planned path. Once adhered, the fiber cannot be repositioned .

Tips and Considerations

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- o Disable Wi-Fi on devices if you want to ensure they use the wired fiber connection .
- o Avoid pinching or cutting the fiber, as it cannot be spliced or repaired .
- o Router Relocation: You can move your router to a central location to improve Wi-Fi coverage while using fiber as a backbone for mesh networks .
- o Aesthetic Integration: The ultra-thin fiber is nearly invisible, preserving your home's decor while providing high-speed, low-latency connectivity .
