

How to connect fiber optic cables to a coupler

To connect a fiber optic cable to a coupler, clean the connectors, align them with the adapter ports, insert each connector securely, and verify the connection for minimal signal loss.

- o Repeat the alignment and insertion process for the second fiber connector on the opposite port of the coupler.
- o Ensure both connectors are fully seated and properly aligned to the internal alignment sleeve, which maintains precise core alignment for efficient light transmission.

Step 5: Verify the Connection

- o Check the connection visually for proper seating.
- o Use a fiber optic tester or power meter to measure insertion loss and confirm the link is functioning.

- o Always handle fibers carefully to avoid contamination or breakage.

- o Use ceramic sleeve adapters for high-precision or high-frequency applications to ensure long-term stability .
- o For repeated connections, ensure the coupler can withstand multiple mating cycles without degrading performance. By following these steps, you can achieve a secure, low-loss connection between two fiber optic cables using a coupler, suitable for temporary patching, testing, or extending fiber runs.
