- o Use high-quality patch cords to minimize insertion loss and return loss.
 - o Avoid mixing single-mode and multimode fibers, as this can prevent the link from functioning ().
 - o For long-term reliability, ensure cables are properly routed and secured to prevent stress or kinks.
 - o If using a media converter, connect the fiber side first, then the copper side, and power on the device to complete the setup ().
