How It Works

Considerations

- o Compatibility: Ensure the converter supports your HDMI version (e.g., HDMI 2.0 or 2.1) and HDCP requirements.
- o Audio Return Channel (ARC): Not all fiber HDMI extenders support ARC; if needed, verify before purchase .
- o Installation: Fiber-optic cables are more delicate than copper HDMI cables, so proper handling and
