

How to estimate the cost of cable tray supports

The price of cable tray supports is calculated by determining the required quantity based on tray length and support spacing, then multiplying by the unit cost of each support, considering material, type, and installation factors.

Step 1: Determine Support Quantity

The number of supports needed depends on the total length of the cable tray and the spacing between supports. The standard formula is:

$$\text{Support Quantity} = (\text{Total Tray Length} / \text{Support Spacing}) + 1$$
