

How to ground a small socket distribution box

Properly grounding a small socket distribution box involves connecting it to a reliable earth ground using appropriately sized conductors and ensuring low resistance connections.

Steps for Grounding

1. Identify Grounding Points: Locate the threaded studs or dedicated ground terminals on the distribution box. For metal boxes, these are usually at the bottom or on a mounting plate inside the box . 2. Select the Correct Ground Wire:

- o In the US, use a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) ground wire for small distribution boxes.
 - o In other regions, a 6 mm² wire is typically required .
 - o For connections to spindles or additional equipment, larger wires (e.g., 6 AWG or 16 mm²) may be needed depending on cable length and load .
3. Connect to the Box: Attach the ground wire to the box using a dedicated ground screw or a grounding lug. Ensure the connection is tight and free of paint or corrosion to maintain good conductivity .
4. Connect to the Main Grounding System: Run a wire from the box's mounting plate or ground terminal to the building's main grounding electrode system, which could be:
- o A copper-clad steel grounding rod driven into the earth (typically 8 feet long, buried at least 80% of its length)
 - o A metal water pipe that is continuously buried for at least 10 feet
 - o A concrete-encased electrode (rebar or copper wire in foundation)
- Ensure the connection is secure and corrosion-resistant .
5. Verify Ground Resistance: The total resistance between the distribution box and the main grounding system should be less than 0.1 ohm for industrial applications, or less than 25 ohms for general safety purposes . Use a ground resistance tester to confirm.
6. Avoid Common Mistakes:
- o Do not double-tap neutrals or share ground points with unrelated circuits.
 - o Avoid using substandard materials like cheap copper-clad rods that corrode quickly .
 - o Ensure all connections are continuous and mechanically secure.
7. Optional Additional Grounding: For longer cable runs or multiple spindles, consider adding a secondary ground wire between the mounting plate and equipment to reduce total resistance and improve safety . By following these steps, your small socket distribution box will be safely grounded, providing a reliable path for stray electricity and protecting both users and equipment from electrical faults.
