

How to shut off the power distribution box at a construction site

- o **Confirm Power is Off:** Test outlets, lights, or equipment in different areas of the site with a voltage tester to ensure the power has been completely disconnected .

Additional Considerations

- o **Labeling and Documentation:** Ensure all connections and circuits are clearly labeled to avoid confusion during shutdown or maintenance .
- o **Coordination:** Inform the site manager and workers before turning off the main power to prevent disruption of critical equipment .
- o **Maintenance and Testing:** After turning off the main power, inspect the distribution box and protective devices for any signs of damage or wear before restoring power .
