Always inspect the cleaved fiber under a microscope to ensure a mirror-like surface before placing it in the splicer . 5. **Plan Cable Layout and Reel Positioning** Position the reel so the fiber feeds in a straight line toward the splicing area. Avoid sharp turns or dragging the cable across rough surfaces. This reduces stress on the fiber and prevents microbends . 6. **Label and Organize Fiber Ends** When working with multi-fiber cables, label each fiber to avoid confusion during splicing. Keep fibers organized to prevent tangling, which can slow down the splicing process and increase the risk of damage . 7. **Monitor Environmental Conditions** Perform splicing in a clean, dust-free environment. Wind, dust, or moisture can contaminate the fiber ends and compromise splice quality. If working outdoors, use a portable splicing enclosure to protect the fiber during deployment . 8. **Follow Manufacturer Guidelines** Always use manufacturer-recommended consumables such as splice sleeves and fusion splicer settings.
