

How to wire a distribution box and its price

Choosing the Right Distribution Box

Select a box based on environment, load capacity, and durability. Indoor boxes are usually plastic and compact, while outdoor or industrial boxes are steel with higher IP/NEMA ratings for water and dust protection . Consider the number of circuits, future expansion, and whether you need additional devices like RCDs or RCBOs .

Installation Location

- o Install in dry, accessible areas with good ventilation.
- o Maintain a height of around 1.5 meters for residential setups; industrial heights vary .
- o Keep away from water, flammable, or corrosive substances.
- o Ensure enough space around the box for maintenance and heat dissipation .

Wiring Steps

- o Turn off the main power to prevent electrical shock .
- o Fix the box securely to the wall, ensuring it is level and stable .
- o Connect the incoming live wire to the main terminal (phase wire to phase terminal, neutral to neutral, ground to ground) .
- o Install circuit breakers in their slots and connect outgoing circuit wires to the corresponding breakers .
- o Arrange wires neatly, secure with zip ties, and leave space for heat dissipation .
- o Perform insulation resistance tests and check each circuit with a multimeter to ensure no short circuits or loose connections .
- o Label all circuits for easy identification and future maintenance .

- o Use UL/CE-certified components and follow NEC, IEC, or local electrical codes .
- o Include protection devices like breakers, fuses, and surge protectors for each circuit .
- o Schedule regular inspections to maintain long-term reliability .
