

How to wire a distribution box without welding

Ensure that live, neutral, and earth wires are correctly connected and clearly labeled . 6. **Secure and Insulate Connections** Tighten all screws and check that wires are firmly held. Cover any exposed conductors with insulating sleeves or electrical tape to prevent short circuits . 7. **Test the Installation** Before restoring power, use a multimeter to verify continuity and ensure there are no short circuits. Once confirmed, switch on the main power and test each circuit individually .
