

# How to wire a double switch in a distribution box

## Article Overview

A double-wire switch can be wired by connecting the incoming hot wire to the common terminal, the load wires to the individual output terminals, and properly grounding the device while keeping neutral wires spliced separately.

## Safety First

Before starting, turn off the circuit breaker supplying the distribution box to prevent electric shock. Verify the circuit is de-energized using a voltage tester. Wear insulated gloves and ensure the workspace is dry.

## Identify the Switch Terminals

A double switch (dual rocker) has:

- o Common terminal(s): Connects to the incoming hot wire. Some switches have a metal bonding tab linking both common terminals, allowing a single hot wire to power both switches.
- o Load terminals: Each switch has its own output terminal for the device it controls.
- o Ground terminal: Usually green, for connecting the grounding wire.

## Wiring Steps

- o Connect the Hot Wire: Attach the incoming hot (black or red) wire from the breaker to the common terminal. If the switch has two common terminals without a bonding tab, use a pigtail to split the hot wire to both terminals .
- o Connect Load Wires: Connect the wire leading to the first appliance (e.g., light) to one load terminal and the second appliance (e.g., fan) to the other load terminal. Ensure you note which wire controls which device for proper orientation .
- o Connect Ground Wire: Twist all bare copper or green-insulated wires together, including a pigtail to the switch's green screw, to provide a safety path for stray current .
- o Handle Neutral Wires: Neutral wires (white) do not connect to the switch terminals. Instead, splice them together securely with a wire nut to maintain a continuous return path to the panel .
- o Secure the Switch: Carefully fold the wires into the distribution box, mount the switch with screws, and attach the wall plate.

## Final Steps

After all connections are made, restore power at the breaker and test each switch to ensure it controls the correct load independently. Double-check that the grounding and neutral connections are secure to prevent

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electrical hazards.

## Tips

- o Use a small clockwise hook on stripped wire ends for secure terminal connections.
- o Label wires if necessary to avoid confusion between loads.
- o Follow NEC standards for wire gauge and terminal torque to ensure long-term safety and reliability . By following these steps, a double-wire switch can safely and effectively control two separate circuits from a single distribution box.
