

How to wire the charging box and power distribution box

Wiring a power distribution box for charging involves connecting a single input source to multiple outputs with proper fusing, grounding, and adherence to electrical codes.

Key Components

- o Connect Output Wires: Attach each output wire to the PDB terminals, ensuring correct polarity and secure connections.
- o Grounding: Connect the PDB's ground terminal to a proper grounding point in your electrical system.
- o Check Connections: Verify all connections are tight, properly insulated, and follow the wiring diagram for your specific charging setup.
- o Power On and Test: Restore power and test each output to ensure proper voltage and functionality without tripping fuses or breakers .

Safety Considerations

- o Always follow local electrical codes and NEC guidelines, especially for EV charging circuits which are considered continuous loads and require 125% sizing of breakers relative to charger rating .
- o Use GFCI protection where required to prevent electric shock.
- o Ensure wire gauge matches the current rating of each circuit to prevent overheating.
- o If unsure, hire a licensed electrician to perform the installation, as improper wiring can cause fire or injury .

EV Charging Integration



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For EV chargers, the PDB can be connected either directly to the main panel or through a subpanel. The wiring should include:

- o Dedicated circuit breakers for each charger.
- o Proper grounding and overcurrent protection.
- o Conduit for routing wires safely from the panel to the PDB and then to the charger . By following these steps and safety measures, your power distribution box will efficiently and safely distribute power to multiple charging points.
