

How to wire the lighting in the distribution box

Testing and Inspection

After wiring, perform insulation resistance tests and circuit continuity checks using a multimeter. Confirm that all breakers, fuses, and components operate correctly and match the circuit requirements. Conduct a final visual inspection to ensure proper installation and safety .

Installation Environment

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Install the distribution box in a dry, ventilated, and accessible location, away from flammable or corrosive substances. For outdoor installations, use a waterproof box with a rain cover. Ensure the box is level, stable, and securely mounted .

Tools and Safety

Use tools such as screwdrivers, wire strippers, multimeters, and insulation testers. Always cut off power before starting work and wear personal protective equipment including insulating gloves, safety glasses, and slip-resistant shoes .
