

Indoor installation price of fiber optic splitter

Splitter Device Costs

Fiber optic splitters are passive devices that divide one optical input into multiple outputs. Common types include PLC (Planar Lightwave Circuit) and FBT (Fused Biconical Taper) splitters. Typical indoor installation for a single splitter can take 1-3 hours, depending on accessibility and building layout.

Total Estimated Cost

Combining device and labor, the total indoor installation cost per fiber optic splitter is approximately:

- o Low-end: \$150-\$200 (small split ratio, easy access, minimal cabling)
- o Average: \$250-\$350 (standard 1x8 or 1x16 PLC splitter, moderate routing)
