By adopting the TIA/EIA-598C standard, you gain a universal "language" of colors that speeds identification, reduces miswiring, and enhances safety. Walk into almost any data center, central office, or network room and you will see fiber patch cables in multiple colors. Those colors are not just cosmetic. In many cases, the cable jacket color tells an engineer what type of fiber is inside, what wavelength it supports, or whether the cable is. In ribbon fiber cables, multiple fibers are arranged side-by-side in a flat, ribbon-like formation.
