Documentation and Coordination

Record all inspection findings in a Material Verification Record (MIR) or Inspection and Test Request (ITR) form. Ensure that any discrepancies are reported to the project engineer for corrective action. Maintain proper documentation to support quality assurance and compliance with standards such as IEC 60364, IEEE, and NEC guidelines .

Storage and Protection

After inspection, store cable trays above ground in a protected area to prevent damage from weather or

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construction activities. Ensure that trays are organized according to type and size, and that they remain accessible for installation .
