

Install the home electrical distribution box in the bedroom

Safety and Code Considerations

Placement and Clearance

- o Height: The panel should be installed approximately 1.5 meters (around 5 feet) from the floor, with the highest breaker handle no more than 6'7" above the floor .
- o Workspace: Maintain at least 30 inches wide and 36 inches deep of clear space in front of the panel for safe operation and maintenance .
- o Ventilation: The area should be dry, well-ventilated, and free from moisture or corrosive substances .
- o Accessibility: The panel door must open fully to 90 degrees, and the box should be easily reachable for emergency shutoff .

Installation Best Practices

- o Choose the right box: Select a distribution box with appropriate load capacity, IP/NEMA rating, and durable materials (steel or plastic for indoor use), .
- o Wiring: Use proper wire gauge, secure grounding, neat cable management, and ensure each circuit has its own breaker or fuse .
- o Protection devices: Include surge protectors and overcurrent protection for safety .
- o Compliance: Follow NEC, IEC, or local building codes, and use UL/CE-certified components .
- o Testing: Perform visual inspections and multimeter tests before powering on .
- o Labeling: Clearly label all circuits for future maintenance and troubleshooting .
