Use mounting rings or open-backed brackets to provide a sturdy anchor for the faceplate and guide cables into the wall cavity. Ensure the box is level and securely fastened. For underground or commercial installations, use appropriate brackets, pallets, or lifting equipment to position the panel safely.

Wiring and Connections

Organize internal wiring to facilitate maintenance and troubleshooting. Use circuit breakers, fuses, and terminal connectors as required for protection and distribution. Ensure that all wires meet electrical specifications and are properly insulated. Maintain separation from high-voltage circuits to prevent interference and comply with safety standards.
