The Trapeze or swing support is the most common type. Thread hex nut 25 mm (1") to 50 mm (2") above location of the tray bottom. The cross member comes next followed by a second set of square washers. All vertical hangers will project through the cross member. Cable tray may be used as the Equipment Grounding Conductor (EGC) in any installation where qualified persons will service the installed cable tray system.
