

Installation of Indoor Distribution Box Fixing Base

Site Selection

- o Surface: Ensure the wall or base is flat, strong, and capable of supporting the box's weight, including internal components like circuit breakers and busbars .

Wiring and Safety Considerations

- o Power Off: Always turn off the main power supply before wiring to ensure safety .
- o Wiring: Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas appropriate for the load. Maintain neat cable management, proper insulation, and clear labeling of circuits .
- o Grounding: The metal box, electrical installation board, and all internal metal components must be properly grounded. Connect the protective neutral wire reliably through the terminal board .
- o Sealing: Ensure all cable inlets and cover joints are tightly sealed to prevent dust or moisture ingress .

Additional Tips

- o Accessibility: Leave enough space around the box for future maintenance and upgrades .
- o Protection Devices: Include circuit breakers, fuses, and surge protectors for each circuit to ensure safety .
- o Compliance: Follow local electrical codes and standards (e.g., NEC, IEC) and use certified components .
- o Inspection: Perform visual checks and multimeter tests before powering on, and schedule regular maintenance to ensure long-term reliability .
