Placement and Mounting

Install the box in a dry, ventilated, and accessible location, typically at 1.5-1.8 meters above the floor for easy operation. Avoid areas near water, flammable, or corrosive substances. Ensure the mounting surface is stable, and use expansion bolts or brackets to secure the box without tilt or looseness .

Wiring and Connections

- o Prepare wires by stripping insulation to the correct length.
- o Connect line, neutral, and protective grounding wires to their respective terminals, following color coding standards.
- o Install circuit breakers according to the load requirements of each circuit.
- o Ensure neat cable management using cable ties and leave space for heat dissipation.
- o Avoid wire tangling and contact with sharp edges .

Safety and Compliance

- o Include protection devices such as breakers, fuses, and surge protectors for each circuit.
- o Use UL/CE-certified components and comply with IEC, NEC, or local electrical codes.
- o Perform insulation resistance tests and visual inspections before powering on.
- o Label each circuit clearly for future maintenance .

Final Checks and Maintenance

- o Clean any debris inside the box after installation.
- o Ensure all screws and terminals are tightened.

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- o Schedule regular inspections to maintain long-term reliability.
