Overview of Fiber Optic Internet

- o FTTC (Fiber to the Cabinet): Fiber reaches a nearby cabinet; the last segment uses copper.
- o FTTP (Fiber to the Premises): Includes homes, businesses, or multi-unit buildings .

Planning and Preparation

- o Determine the best route for fiber, considering underground ducts, aerial poles, or micro-trenching .
- o Select the appropriate fiber type: single-mode (OS2) for long distances or future-proofing, multimode (OM3/OM4) for shorter runs .
- o Gather tools and materials: fiber cables, ONT, termination kits, cleaver, cable stripper, and safety gear .

Installation Methods

Fiber can be installed using several methods:

- o Underground ducting: Micro-ducts or conduits, often using directional drilling to cross roads or water .
- o Aerial cabling: Fiber attached to utility poles.
- o Trenching or micro-trenching: Narrow trenches for new builds or urban areas .

Connecting to the Home

- o Fiber drop cable: Runs from the distribution point (fiber pod or terminal) to the home.
- o Network Interface Device (NID): A small box outside the home where fiber is coiled and terminated .
- o Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Converts light signals into electrical data for devices; installed inside or outside the home .
- o Router or gateway: Connects to the ONT via Ethernet to distribute internet throughout the home. For larger homes, mesh Wi-Fi systems may be added .

- o Wear gloves and eye protection to prevent fiber splinters and laser exposure .
- o Avoid bending fiber beyond its minimum bend radius to prevent signal loss or damage .
- o Keep the work area organized and avoid interference with other utilities.

- o Test the fiber connection for speed and signal quality.
- o Configure the router, update firmware, and optimize Wi-Fi placement.
