- o Housing main switches, MCBs, MCCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, busbars, neutral and earth bars, and surge protection devices .
- o Providing circuit control, overload protection, short-circuit protection, and leakage protection .
- o Managing power distribution for an entire building, multiple floors, or industrial equipment, ensuring safety and efficiency . Distribution boards are essential for centralized power management, allowing isolation of individual circuits for maintenance without disrupting the entire system.
